RULES

Rules according to the ITF (https://itftkd.sport/rules/)
Coaches must wear a training suit and indoor sports shoes.

Equipment: All participants must wear official ITF dobok and protective equipment according to ITF rules.

- Helmet (blue or red depending on the draw)
- Hand and foot equipment (color is not important)
- ➤ In all sparring categories, competitors must use open-handed gloves without bandages.

An electronic scoring system will be used during the matches.

In the elimination rounds, competitors perform one form, and in the finals, two forms. Forms are assigned by the referees. If competitors hold different ranks, the highest form of the lower-ranked competitor can be assigned.

During the weigh-in, there will be zero tolerance.

Any competitor who fails to meet the weigh-in requirements for their category will be immediately disqualified from the competition.

Individual Pattern or Sparring categories with fewer than four (4) competitors may be merged with another category, subject to coaches' approval. In the case of Patterns, the merged category will use patterns appropriate to the lowest rank.





REFEREES

Referees will be compensated based on their quality and expertise. Only the best will be selected. We want to emphasize that our goal is to organize the competition with top referees to ensure the highest quality judging.

The deadline for referee registration is September 17, 2025. Referees who wish to apply are kindly requested to contact the organizers via email or phone (Viber & WhatsApp).

PROTEST

The official protest must be submitted within 5 minutes after the match and presented to the main referee along with a fee of 50 EUR. In case the protest is upheld, the fee will be refunded. Only an accredited coach is authorized to file an official protest.

ACCOMMODATION

If you require assistance with accommodation, please contact the organizer well in advance. Alternatively, you are welcome to arrange your own stay using platforms such as Booking.com or Airbnb.

AWARDS

Medals and certificates will be presented to the athletes finishing in 1st, 2nd, and both 3rd places. Additionally, the top performer in each category will be honored with a trophy, along with the clubs placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall.

LUNCH

The organizer will provide lunch for referees and coaches at the restaurant, and all competitors will receive a lunch package.

If you have any dietary requirements due to religious customs, please contact the organizer in advance to ensure your meal is properly prepared.







By its size and strategic importance, Petrovaradin Fortress is one of the largest and most well-preserved fortresses in Europe. Often referred to as the "Gibraltar on the Danube," it was built between 1692 and 1780 and served as a vital military stronghold on the border of the Habsburg Monarchy. The fortress is a remarkable example of baroque military architecture and today stands as a major cultural and historical monument in Serbia.

Novi Sad is the second-largest city in Serbia and an important cultural, economic, and administrative center. Often called the "Serbian Athens" for its rich cultural heritage and vibrant artistic scene, Novi Sad sits on the banks of the Danube River. The city is known for its diverse architecture, historic landmarks, and as the host of the famous EXIT music festival, attracting visitors from around the world.





Dunavski Park is one of the most beautiful and well-known green spaces in Novi Sad. Located in the city center, it offers a peaceful escape from the urban hustle. The park was established in the 19th century and features a picturesque pond, walking paths, and a variety of native and exotic plant species. As a protected natural monument, Dunavski Park is not only a favorite spot for relaxation, but also a symbol of the city's harmony with nature.

The Grape Harvest Days, also known as "Grožđebal," is the largest, oldest, and most visited tourist and economic event in the region. A rich, high-quality, and diverse program offers something for everyone's taste. There are concerts, exhibitions, children's costume parades, and carnivals — and wine and sausages are everywhere. This year, the event will take place from 20th to 22nd September, 2025, in Sremski Karlovci, near Petrovaradin.
